Day 1: Welcome Aboard! Settle back, relax and enjoy a leisurely drive to the scenic **New York Finger Lakes** region. Our first destination is the **Fry Brother's Turkey Ranch** in Trout Run, Pennsylvania, for a delicious lunch. Following our lunch, we continue onto the **Robert H. Treman State Park** in Ithaca, New York. Robert H. Treman State Park is an area of wild beauty, with the rugged gorge called Enfield Glen as its scenic highlight. Winding trails follow the gorge past 12 waterfalls, including the 115-foot Lucifer Falls to where visitors can see a mile-and-a-half down the wooded gorge as it winds its way to the lower park. *Note: Minimal walking is required to enjoy the Lucifer Falls.* Later we arrive at **Six Mile Creek Vineyard** for a wine tasting before checking into the **Country Inn & Suites** for the next three nights. Tonight, we are treated to a scrumptious dinner at one of Ithaca's finest restaurants, **ZaZa's Cucina**.

Day 2: After breakfast at the hotel, we depart for a day of sightseeing. We begin at **Lively Run Goat Dairy** in Interlaken, New York. Enjoy a visit to the barn and see the goats. We end the tour with a **cheese tasting**. Next we travel to **Lakewood Vineyards** in **Watkins Glen, New York**, for a wine tasting. Following a tasty lunch at **Seneca Harbor Station Restaurant**, sit back and relax on board **Captain Bill's Seneca Lake Cruises** for a 50-minute narrated sightseeing cruise on Seneca Lake. Discover the beauty and charm of Seneca Lake as it can only be seen from water. You will be captivated by Hector Falls! At 165-feet, Hector Falls is a beautiful and gigantic waterfall that tumbles over a broad expanse of shale and limestone rock that makes its way down to Seneca Lake. Next we depart for **Watkins Glen State Park**. Within a span of two miles, the glen's stream descends 400-feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade. You may choose to be dropped at the bottom of the gorge and use the main walking trail leading to the top of the gorge. You may wish to enjoy viewing the gorge from the bottom only and then walk *on your own* to downtown Watkins Glen (*approximately 1/3 mile*), or you can be dropped at the top of the gorge to enjoy the views. *Note: The gorge trail leading to the top includes over 800 steps and is of moderate intensity, and the trail down is more difficult than going up.* Before returning to our hotel in Ithaca, we enjoy a delicious dinner at the **Boatyard Grill**, a casual, waterfront, nautical-themed restaurant.

Day 3: After breakfast **at the hotel**, we depart for another day of **exploration**. We begin at **Taughannock Falls State Park** and visit one of the outstanding natural attractions of the northeast, the **Taughannock Falls**, which plunges 215-feet past rocky cliffs that tower nearly 400-feet above its gorge. You may choose to enjoy the easy walking trail (*1.5 miles round trip*) to the base of the gorge or wait until we arrive by motor coach to the **Taughannock Falls Overlook** for wonderful views of the falls cataract with a drop of 215-feet making it one of the highest falls east of the Rocky Mountains. Next we travel to **Parker's Grille & Tap House** in Seneca Falls, New York, for a delicious deli buffet lunch then we're off to the **Montezuma**

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Winery & Hidden Marsh Distillery to enjoy a tasting of selected wines with some free time to browse and shop. Next we depart for **Smokey Hollow Maple Syrup** in Jordan, New York. Enjoy learning how modern-day maple sugaring is done in this small modern but quaint sugar shack. Our visit includes a tour, tasty samples and some free time to browse and shop. Next we travel to the **Willard Memorial Chapel** in Auburn, New York, for a guided tour and a 20-minute **musical program** on the historic Steere and Turner Tracker Organ. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this Romanesque building includes an interior completely executed by the Tiffany Glass and Decorating Company and is believed to be the only complete and unaltered Tiffany chapel known to exist. Before returning to our hotel in Ithaca, we enjoy a scrumptious dinner at the quaint **Springside Inn**.

Day 4: After breakfast at the hotel, we depart for Corning, New York, and the **Corning Museum of Glass**. Before our tour make your own sandblasted glass souvenir to take home with you. Our docent tour guide will educate us on both the history and the changing exhibitions such as the new Contemporary Glass Gallery installation. See the world's best glass collection and explore 35 centuries of glassmaking through nearly 50,000 objects – from a tiny glass portrait of an ancient Egyptian pharaoh to larger-than-life contemporary sculpture and daily hot glass shows. Following a delicious luncheon, settle back and enjoy a movie on our drive home while reminiscing about our get-away with many fond memories of our delightful Finger Lakes and waterfall adventures!
