TUITION AND REGISTRATION

Registration for the **2017-2018** school year will be held at the school in room 208, according to the following schedule:

January 24th (snow date January 26th):

9:15 a.m. for currently-enrolled families

10:00 a.m. for SPUMC members

January 31st (snow date February 2nd):

9:15 a.m. for alumni families

10:00 a.m. for general public

At the time of registration, we collect a \$90.00 non-refundable registration fee and one month's tuition payment, which is applied toward May of the year for which the child is being enrolled. Families enrolling more than one child for the year will pay the full registration fee and tuition for the first child. Each additional child's registration will be \$80.00, and his/her tuition will be reduced by \$20.00 per month.

ENROLLMENT

All SPUMCNS students must meet the following requirements:

1. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1st. A copy of the child’s birth certificate must be submitted to register.
2. Every child must be up-to-date on all immunizations, as documented on a form signed by the physician and kept at the school.
3. All children must be fully toilet trained and able to use the toilet and wash hands independently.
4. Our school is nut- and peanut- free and serves a daily snack. However, parents of children with food allergies or dietary restrictions must provide their child’s snack.
