## TUITION AND REGISTRATION

Registration for the **2018-2019** school year will be held at the school in room 208, according to the following schedule:

January 23rd (snow date January 25th):

## ENROLLMENT

All SPUMCNS students must meet the following requirements:

1. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1st. A copy of the child’s birth certificate must be submitted to register.
2. Every child must be up-to-date on all immunizations, as documented on a form signed by the physician and kept at the school.
3. All children must be fully toilet trained and able to use the toilet and wash hands independently.
4. Our school is nut- and peanut- free and serves a daily snack. However, parents of children with food allergies or dietary restrictions must provide their child’s snack.
