Faith & Race Book Group

In September, Rev. Ron started a monthly **Faith & Race Book Group** to help us explore issues of racial justice and reconciliation. So far we've read *Just Mercy* (Bryan Stevenson), *Raising White Kids* (Jennifer Harvey) and Trevor Noah's memoir, *Born a Crime*. In January we'll read and discuss Jim Wallis' book, *America's Original Sin* on **January 22** at **7pm**. You are welcome to come join in any time you think we're reading something good (*To Kill a Mockingbird* is on the docket later this spring!) or join the conversation each month on the fourth Tuesday in the Parlor.

Intentional Acts of Kindness

This Advent we've given out over \$22,000 in one hundred-dollar bills in worship thanks to the generosity of several families and individuals in our church asking people to use **their hearts** and imagination to share the love of **Christ with someone who needs it**.

The stories have been pouring in ever since. We've learned how someone bought a hundred-dollar cup of hot chocolate from two young girls raising money for backpacks for the homeless. We've heard about people reaching out to friends, family members and total strangers facing sickness, financial hardship or other challenges. One participant sent books to a church library in El Salvador while another sent solar powered lights to a village in Africa. Most of the money has been spent locally,
