

Why Doodle Devos?

Kids need to think creatively. Each doodle is designed to jump-start kids' natural creativity and spark new ideas.

Kids need to communicate. These pages allow kids to communicate visually and verbally. After kids doodle, draw, tear, fold, or color a page, they share it with someone or post it for others to see.

Kids need to think critically. Our doodles get kids noodling! These fun designs prompt kids to think outside the box and consider the best drawing or response for each page.

Kids need a context. These doodle pages help kids put Bible verses into a framework that fits their current frame of mind, allowing them to apply the Bible in new ways.

Kids need fun. These doodles are fun. Try one or two. There's a doodle in here for you, too!

How To Doodle:

1. A Personal Doodle Devo

Print a copy of this book for each child in your ministry. Be sure to print the pages one-sided. Some pages will be to torn, shredded, shared, or folded. We don't want kids trashing pages to be treasured.

Allow kids to choose which devos they do each day. This will allow the Holy Spirit to speak to each child in a unique way. As kids interact with the pages, the devo will be transformed; just like God's Word is transforming them.


2. A Worship Response

3. Children's Church

Choose a doodle page to enhance your children's church curriculum. Have kids share their creative creations with family and friends after worship.



on their bulletin board.**





Let them go.








**Decorate this bear for

—2 Corinthians 5:17





“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”








**These balloons are prayers

“Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always.”






**Draw the key that unlocks
